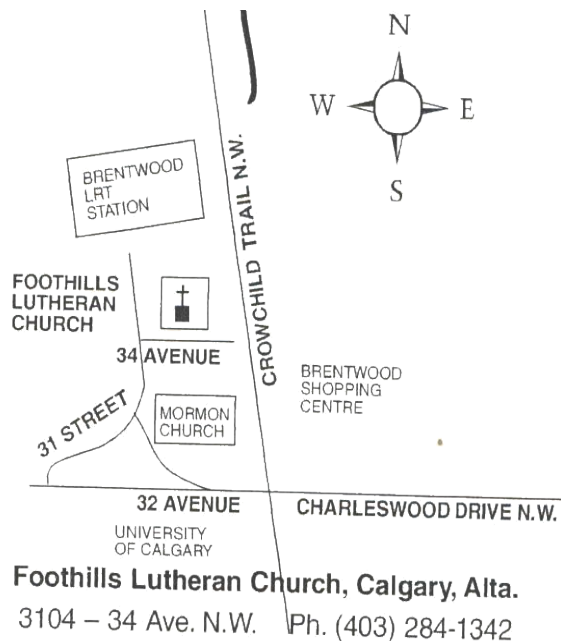

What Is FLSR?

FLSR serves two purposes: providing intentional Christian community for the residents, and providing a base community for wider ministry to post-secondary students. First preference will be given to Lutheran students.

The house has 4 bedrooms, and will accommodate 4 students. This small Christian community will intentionally reflect together in sorting out the issues of study, lifestyle, and life in community. They will share chores, and early in each term they will negotiate a covenant that addresses their life together, and how they wish to participate in campus ministry and/or Foothills Lutheran Church.

The house itself is a newly renovated bungalow (the former parsonage), set on a grassy hillside with fruit trees, an area for a garden, a large kitchen, a common living room/dining room and a fireplace.

The house is within walking distance of the University of Calgary, a short walk to the nearest C-Train station and a 10 minute ride to SAIT and the Alberta College of Art and Design, and one bus ride from Mount Royal College.

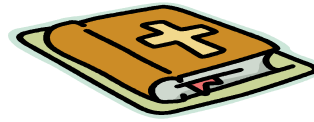
Campus Ministries may include using some of the house facilities (e.g. using the living room for a weekly bible study) and this use will be negotiated with the house students in advance.

FLSR is co-ed, although the mix will vary from year to year. DLSR is ideally suited for students who are engaged in full-time post-secondary studies.

Winter students may continue to live in the house over the summer months, but the setting will be less structured. Rooms not occupied by winter residents are rented out to other students over the summer. Depending on availability, residency may be limited to two years.

FLSR follows the example of long-standing Lutheran Student houses in Waterloo, London, Saskatoon, Edmonton, and Vancouver.

OUR CHURCH



Foothills Lutheran Church had been sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in the Calgary area for 40 years. The purpose of our church is to “Make Disciples for Jesus”, which is taken from the words of our Lord in Matthew 28. The Lutheran Church is a confessing church and we believe that...

THE HOLY BIBLE...

is the Word of God, written by men who were moved by the Holy Spirit; therefore the Bible is without error and the source of all we believe.

GOD...

is triune, the only true God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, three distinct persons in one divine being.

MAN...

was created by God in His own image and was given a rational soul. Although created holy and innocent, Adam and Eve, of their own free choice, fell into sin, thus separating themselves from God. All people being descendants of Adam and Eve, are sinful from conception. Because of sin, everyone is subject to death and eternal damnation; for God said, “The wages of sin is death” (Romans 6:23).

But...

JESUS CHRIST...

is the Messiah, the Son of God and the Son of Man. God the Father, purely out of love and mercy, redeemed mankind by sending His one and only Son to die on the cross for the sins of the world. By His perfect life, Jesus fulfilled the Law for us. By His suffering and death He paid the price for our sins. By His resurrection He defeated death, Satan, and sin forever. God has promised that everyone who believes in Jesus “will not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16).

FAITH...

is knowing and accepting Jesus Christ as our personal Saviour and trusting Him alone for our salvation. The Holy Spirit creates this saving faith in the hearts of people through the Gospel of Jesus Christ when it is read or heard from the Bible.

THE SACRAMENTS...

are sacred acts instituted by God Himself in which there are certain visible means connected with His Word and by which He offers, gives, and seals to us the forgiveness earned for us by Christ. These sacraments are Holy Baptism and the Lord’s Supper.

These basic beliefs are dealt with more thoroughly in the pastor’s Adult Information Class. The teachings of the Lutheran Church are from God’s Word and correctly presented in the Book of Concord.
