

Kids in the DIVINE SERVICE



What is the “Benediction”?

The Benediction (pronounced ben-eh-DIK-shun) is God’s blessing for the congregation given through the pastor at the very end of the service. There are several different benedictions that we use in the church. The “Aaronic Benediction” is the one that we use in the Divine Service. You can find this in Numbers 6:24–26. We use the other benedictions in prayer services like Matins and Vespers. Can you find the benedictions for these services in your hymnal?

Why is there a Benediction in the Divine Service?

The word “Benediction” comes from a Latin word meaning “to speak well.” When the pastor pronounces the Benediction, God is giving us His blessing, or “speaking well” to us. He sends us on our way with His blessing after we have received all of His wonderful gifts through the Word and Sacraments. God sure does a lot of giving to His people!

FOR PARENTS

Before or after the Divine Service, direct your children to the various services in the hymnal. Encourage them to find and read the benedictions for each service. Help them find the Aaronic Benediction.
