

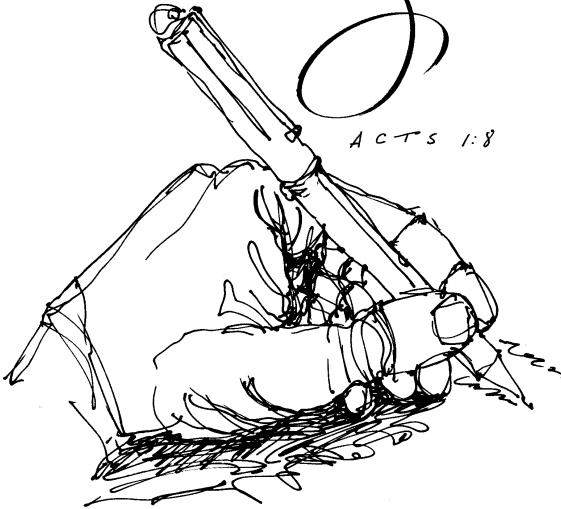

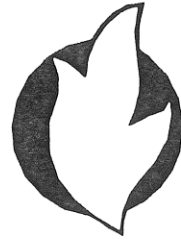

What is “Pentecost”?

The word “Pentecost” (pronounced PEN-tih-kost) comes from a Greek word meaning “fiftieth.” Exactly fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead, the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples. Everyone there saw tiny flames of fire on the disciples’ heads.

Why is Pentecost so important?

When Jesus died, the disciples were sad because they thought that their Friend and Lord was gone forever. But Jesus rose again! Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus did finally ascend into heaven leaving the disciples below. However, before Jesus actually died, rose again and ascended into heaven, He made a promise to His disciples that He would send His Holy Spirit to them. He said that the Holy

Spirit would come and guide them “into all truth” (John 16:13). As you can see, Jesus doesn’t leave us alone to fend for ourselves. Jesus is here with us. His Holy Spirit guides and leads the church into the truth of the wonderful Gospel! We celebrate and remember all of this at Pentecost.

FOR PARENTS

At home, read the story of Pentecost in Acts 2 to your children. Remind them that the Holy Spirit comes to us through the Word and Sacraments just as our Lord has promised. Encourage them to thank God for the gift of His Holy Spirit in their lives.
