

MISSION OF THE MONTH

Lutheran Association of Missionaries & Pilots (LAMP)

LAMP's volunteers and staff from Canada and the United States share the love of Jesus to Indigenous people in communities in remote northern Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and British Columbia through Christ-centered Bible studies and other outreach projects. Each year over 5,000 youth and adults are impacted by the ministry of LAMP.

- Is gender binary or fluid?
- What does the Bible say about transitioning?
- How do I respond to people whose physical body doesn't match their declared gender?
- What does it mean to use the correct pronouns?
- How can I share the Gospel with someone who is transgender?

This little book, geared toward youth but useful for anyone with questions about this topic, gives you the answers you need to approach these questions from a godly, loving perspective.
