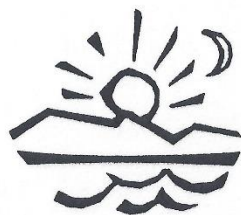

What is “Matins”?

Today we receive our Lord’s gracious gifts through the Order of Matins. The word “Matins” comes from a Latin word meaning “of the morning.” Matins is a service of prayer that is used by the church only in the morning.

Why do we use the Order of Matins?

Matins has been around for a long time. The Order of Matins has been used by Christians almost since the beginning of Christianity. At the beginning of the day, Christians would pray to start their day off right! You can use the Order of Matins this way, too! When you wake up in the morning, grab your hymnal and try it! What better than to begin each morning deep in God’s wonderful Word! If you’re not sure how to do it, then ask your pastor. He’d be glad to help you!

FOR PARENTS

It can be quite easy for children to learn and enjoy the liturgy of the church when a parent shows them how. As parents know quite well, children rely upon routines in their lives that are put in place by parents. Matins can become a part of the morning devotional routine at your house.
