### FROM PASTOR BODE'S LETTER ON THE COVID-19 CONCERNS:

We will all do everything we can to practice good hygiene, using hand sanitizer and being mindful of our own symptoms.

Finally, let us pray-pray for God's mercy as we face this time. Let us pray for a faith that trusts Him, and which will not be overwhelmed by fear.
