AS OFTEN HAPPENS IN THE SUMMER MONTHS our stewardship has dropped off from a rather positive beginning under COVID. We continue to seek to be good stewards of God's gifts to us and pray that we all may be faithful in using what He has first given to us, to the glory of His name.

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES AND CONFIRMATION CLASSES CONTINUE TODAY as we gather in the study of God's Word. Adult Bible Study will begin next Sunday, September 26th. We will be observing physical distancing protocols; masks will be required; sanitizing stations will be available. We ask you to bring your own bible, as we will not be distributing books for general use at this time.

BIBLE STUDY OPPORTUNITIES: We are looking at the beginning of our LifeLight studies, or another form of Tuesday morning study. If you are interested in studies like these, please let the pastors or Deaconess Miriam know.

AS WE SEEK TO RETURN TO SOME "NORMAL", we remind you of some of the things we do for everyone's well-being:

- Extra time should be given to enter the building, to go through screening and sanitizing. For worship, please use the main entry doors. We do realize that this will mean some extra outside steps for some members. To provide extra parking space in the upper lot, the staff will park in the bottom lot at the back. You may use these spaces on Sunday.
- If you are entering through the lower level, please use the west (preschool) doors. The lower north (glass) doors will not be open. Every door must have sanitization stations and a screening person. We do not have the space nor the personnel for this at those doors.
- We have marked directions for travel. We hope that you will be conscious of the direction think of driving, and keep to the right!. Please observe spacing, too. On that note, please remember that if you stop somewhere to chat, you are going to hold up the line for many people. Please be considerate of this.
- Please do not wander in the building. Contact areas will have to be sanitized after use. Help us keep those areas to a minimum.
- As hard--even unLutheran--as it may seem we won't be having coffee hours or other social activities. Conversations are best outdoors, still observing physical distancing.
- Please follow the directions of the volunteers. They are working for your safety, too.

Worship continues as it has; we will still be doing screening and designating seating; we will seat our members in ways that make the best use of our space. Masks are required.

We are working hard to provide the opportunities for our growth and fellowship while still recognizing the needs for safety and caution, especially so we care for all our members. As we have noted in the past, please do not attend if you have any symptoms, have travelled, etc. (you know the routine!) Let us continue to pray that God, in His grace, would deliver His people from this pandemic and bring us together in the joy of our lives as His children in Jesus Christ!

AS STUDENTS MOVE AWAY FOR SCHOOL, or move to Calgary for their studies, we want to encourage them in their spiritual life. If you, or someone you know, is moving to another city for study, please share that with Pastor Eric. We will try to get them connected with a local church. If you know a student moving to Calgary, let him know that, too, so we can reach out to them and invite them to join us.
