OUR MEN'S BIBLE STUDY will meet on Saturday, June 5^{th} , and we will look at Matthew, the former tax collector. We meet at 9:00 am – sorry that we cannot serve you breakfast, but we

do invite you to join us in the Word. We meet at church, observing COVID protocols, and we wrap up by 10:30. We invite all the men to come and join us.

TRINITY SUNDAY: As the Scriptures declare: "Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness". (1 Timothy 3:16, ESV) Yet, during the first thousand years of Christianity there was no special feast in honour of this mystery since every day of the liturgical year was devoted to the honour and praise of the Triune God. However, in response to the Arian heresy (320-380), which denied the full divinity of the Son, a special Mass in honour of the Holy Trinity was introduced into Roman liturgical books. This Mass was not assigned a definite day but could be used on certain Sundays according to the discretion of the parish priest. Beginning in the ninth century bishops of several dioceses in northern Europe promoted a special feast of the Holy Trinity on the Sunday after Pentecost, though Popes Alexander II in the eleventh century and Alexander III in the twelfth century, regarded this unnecessary and discouraged the observance. Finally, in 1334, Pope John XXII accepted the festival into the official calendar of the Western Church and directed tat it should be celebrated everywhere on the Sunday after Pentecost. Today, the feast of the Holy Trinity is among the great festivals of Christianity.

Apart from reciting the Athanasian Creed, there is no special liturgical observance associated with the feast. We do celebrate through the our use of the sign of the cross and the singing of the Doxology (the Gloria Patri).

Trinity Sunday is one of the few festivals on the calendar that celebrates a doctrine rather than an event. Thus, Trinity Sunday has a central position on the calendar, concluding the half year of our Lord and beginning the half year of the Church. The vestments are white in honour of the holiness, mystery, and glory of the Triune God.

One of the great Trinitarian hymns is St. Patrick's Breastsplate (LW172) written by Patrick c. 400, in which we sing:

I bind unto myself today The strong name of the Trinity By invocation of the same The Three in One and One in Three.
