

**THE BEGINNING OF ADVENT** is a call to prepare for the coming days of our Lord's appearing, including the celebration of His coming as the Babe of Bethlehem. We are in our planning and preparation stages, and are planning services for Christmas Eve at 4:00 pm, 6:00

pm and 11:00 pm (as needed/desired). We will post these on our registration site early in December. We will not be accepting any registrations until that time. Yet you can let your pastors and elders know that you plan to be here, so that we can determine how best to provide for our worship in those days.

**WITH MULTIPLE CHRISTMAS SERVICES** it will be necessary to sanitize the pews before each service. With many hands this is a relatively simple task. Our caretaker, Brian Vincent, would love to have your help. Let him know, or let us know in the office, that you can assist with this.

The Oromo congregation will also be returning to worship December 5<sup>th</sup>. We will need to sanitize each week, to enable them to be able to worship. They will sanitize after their service. Again, if you can help, please let us know.

MANY OF OUR MEMBERS HAVE SWITCHED THEIR GIVING to electronic contributions and no longer require offering envelopes. We will order our 2023 offering envelopes in January to take advantage of early order discounts. Please let the church office know if you no longer require offering envelopes and we will adjust our order. If we don't hear from you, we will proceed with ordering envelopes for you. ## Advent

Advent is a time for preparing, a time of waiting and watching. We celebrate Advent with the colour BLUE as this communicates the message of hope. Our Christian faith rests on the hope that one day Jesus will come again.
