HOLY COMMUNION - One of the great blessings of our Lord's Passion is the gift of His Body and Blood, given for the forgiveness of sins. We welcome to the Lord's altar all members of Lutheran Church–Canada, and those in fellowship with LCC who desire to commune with us; we ask guests and visitors to speak with the

pastor or an elder before the service.

As we come to the Lord's Table today, we prepare our hearts by asking:

- 1. Do I believe that the Risen Christ is my only Lord and Saviour from sin, death and the devil?
- 2. Do I believe that the Risen Christ is really present in the Sacrament and that with the bread and wine I receive His true Body and Blood?
- 3. Do I resolve to dedicate, with the help of God, my life to the service of my Lord in His Body, the Church, by regular worship, thankful living and sacrificial living?

You may also wish to use the prayers before communing and after receiving the Sacrament, printed on the inside cover of the hymnal. You can also use Luther's Christian Questions and Answers, on p. 329 of the hymnal.

On Easter day we celebrate the victory Jesus has won for us. Jesus did not stay dead. He was raised to new life. WHITE or GOLD are the colours of Easter and represent victory, resurrection and eternal life.

Creative Response

Easter Sunday is the most important day of the church year, but the celebration of Easter does not end there.

It continues for a full fifty days, right through to Pentecost. These 50 days of Easter are a wonderful opportunity to explore and celebrate Easter more fully.

Make up a large cross out of cardboard or wood. Cut out 50 'flowers' from sheets of coloured paper. Each morning or evening of the Easter season, ask a household member to share something they saw or experienced during the day which gives cause to say 'Alleluia.' Have them place a flower on the cross.

On Pentecost Sunday (June 9th) you will have a colourful reminder of God's good work in your lives.
