

God Serves His People: Our Lutheran Way of Worship: Confession and Absolution

The psalmist asks: "Who shall ascend the hill of the Lord? And who shall stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully. (Psalm 24:3-4-ESV) We know that we have turned from God to follow our own desires. That is why it is important that we come before our God openly and honestly, with hearts, confessing our unworthiness and sinfulness, and asking for His forgiveness. And God has heard our prayer as we hear the message of forgiveness proclaimed in the absolution by the Lord's called servant.

We are so blessed to find this grace of God. It is the heart of our worship. In the Large Catechism, Martin Luther writes: "Everything, therefore, in the Christian Church is ordered toward this goal: we shall daily receive in the Church nothing but the forgiveness of sin through the Word and signs (that is, the Sacraments), to comfort and encourage our consciences as long as we live here." (SC II, 55)
