

What is "Palm Sunday"?

The Sunday before Jesus was crucified by His people, they honored and adored Him as their Lord and King with palm branches. We remember this as the beginning of Christ's final, bitter walk to the cross.

Why did the people honor and adore Him on Palm Sunday and then kill Him five days

later on Good Friday?

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, all of the people began to praise and honor Him as their King. They believed Him to be a powerful leader who would overthrow the Roman government and make Israel a free nation again. When Jesus did not do this, the people wanted Him crucified. You and I know what kind of a King He is. He's the King who came to die for the sins of His people. Wow! What a King!

FOR PARENTS

Remind your children how important it was that Jesus died for their sins. (Be careful to note if the children say, "died to save our sins," and correct them). That is exactly what He came to earth to do. He came to pay the price that we could never pay ourselves. Direct your children to the symbols in the sanctuary that reflect Christ's death. Remind them that we will hear of His victory over death next Sunday at Easter!
