God Serves His People:

Our Lutheran Way of Worship: The Scripture Lessons

We now come to one of the high points in our service, as we pause and listen as God speaks to us in His word. In the readings, God speaks through the prophets, men of the Old Testament who wrote of the Christ who was yet to come. Then we hear from the apostles, usually the letters (epistles) of St. Paul. The crown jewel of the Service of the Word is the reading of the Gospel, the very words and earthly actions of Jesus, our Lord and Savior.

We follow a system of lessons known as a pericope, which is used to guide us in the Word. This keeps us from becoming narrow in our study of the Word, and brings to our remembrance the triumphant deeds of our Lord, as well as proclaiming His holy will for us as we live in this world and reassuring us of His promises to us as His children.

The Gradual may be a psalm text, helping us focus on the lesson theme. Then, in the Alleluia Verse, we respond joyfully to the Word of God–it is the Word of Life!
