CREATIVE RESPONSE

Ascension Day falls on the 40th day after Easter Sunday. It marks the last earthly appearance of the Lord Jesus after his resurrection. You can find the stories about it in Acts 1:1-12; Luke 24:50-53; Mark 16:19; Matthew 28:16-20.
