

# MISSION OF THE MONTH: THE MUSTARD SEED

The Mustard Seed is a Christian non-profit organization that has been caring for individuals experiencing homelessness and poverty since 1984. Operating in

seven cities across Western Canada, The Mustard Seed is a supportive haven where people can have their physical, mental, and spiritual needs met and grow toward greater health and independence.

Programs and services include basic needs – emergency shelter, meals, clothing, and hygiene items, health and wellness, housing, employment, spiritual care, community engagement, community impact centres.

**NEW PRESIDENT OF CONCORDIA LUTHERAN SEMINARY:** On July 31 the Concordia Lutheran Seminary Board of Regents issued a call to Rev. Jonathan Kraemer (currently serving at All Saints' Lutheran Church, Edmonton), to the position of President. AS STUDENTS PREPARE TO RETURN TO UNIVERSITY it is a good time to remind you of our *Policy for Student Parking*. We have established the following guidelines, and application forms are available through the office.

- A Priority Qualified Student ("PQS") is allowed a parking space at no charge. A PQS is a student attending the University of Calgary who is an active, communicant member of the church. (They attend and commune regularly.)
- A Qualified Student ("QS") is a student that is a member of Foothills Lutheran Church who is not active; however, their parents or grandparents are active as described above. A qualified student will be granted parking privileges at half the public rate (\$200.00 per semester).
- Remaining spaces (there is a limit of 32 available in total) will be rented to those who apply, at a cost of \$400.00 per semester.

If you know of someone who may be interested in parking here at the church, please share this information with them. Spaces are available on a first come, first served basis.

**CHILDREN'S CHOIR** will resume **September 11** with a parent meeting and a short rehearsal. Children age 4-10 meet twice monthly to learn God's Word through song. If you are interested in having your children participate, please contact Deaconess Miriam for more details.

### CREATIVE RESPONSE

God spoke to his people through the prophet Isaiah about his holy day. He said: "Honour my holy day. Do not work on it. Do not do just anything you want to. Do not talk about things that are worthless. Then you will find your joy in me."

How does your household observe the Lord's Day? Try these ideas:

- After you go to church talk together about what took place there. What did God do for you? What did you learn? How might you apply what you have learnt this week?
- Make time on Sundays to share your 'Highs' and 'Lows' from the past week and to talk and pray about the upcoming week.
- Set aside quiet time each Sunday in your home a time without TV, music or other forms of media.



### ACTION RESPONSE

Isaiah 58:7 says: Share your food with the hungry, and give shelter to the homeless. Give clothes to those who need them, and do not hide from relatives who need your help.

Plan one action this week in response to this verse. For example you might make a donation to a food bank or an organisation that feeds the homeless or volunteer your time to help them distributing the food. You may give clothes to an op shop or volunteer at an op shop. You may visit an elderly relative.
